4. <b>Benjamin Banneker</b>		d. Associate Justice of the Supreme Court who argued <i>Brown v. Board of Education</i> in 1954
5. <b>George Washington Carver</b>		e. American trumpeter, nicknamed "Satchmo," one of the most influential figures in jazz
6. <b>Thurgood Marshall</b>		f. Almanac author who helped survey the original boundaries of the District of Columbia
7. <b>Barbara Jordan</b>		g. Led a two-day slave rebellion in Virginia in 1831
8. <b>Harriet Tubman</b>		h. Track and field athlete who set 3 world records and won 4 gold medals at the 1936 Berlin Olympics
9. <b>Sojourner Truth</b>		i. Civil rights activist and first black U.S. Representative to come from the Deep South
